

Anticipated Costs for NSG 101 (This is an anticipated costs sheet only, and is subject to change)

1. A majority of the required books for N101 are in a bundled package at the bookstore and cost approximately \$538. Prep-U is a required item that is included in the bundle.
2. Pathophysiology book is approximately \$140.55.
3. Drug Calculation on-line is approximately \$99.95.
4. Nurse Pack purchase at the bookstore has all items necessary for skill testing in the entire program and cost approximately \$110.65.
5. ATI is the testing company our program uses to assist students' ability to measure their understanding of content. This fee includes the Self-Assessment test and the critical thinking test, the NSG fundamentals test and the second semester ATI tests. Costs for fall are approximately \$352.85. The TEAS test is a separate fee of \$57.15.
6. Littman Stethoscope Select is \$57.98 and the Classic II E is \$94.98. Either is a good stethoscope but if you can afford it is recommend the Classic IIE or one step above the Classic IIE.
7. Embroidered uniform tops are required to be purchased through the bookstore. Price is approximately \$ 21.98 for the top. Students will have the opportunity to try on samples during orientation for size. White pants may be purchased anywhere but should be comfortable with movement and sufficient quality as not to be seen through easily. The bookstore has lab coats at the cost of approximately \$42.98 but you are allowed to purchase a plain white lab coat anywhere.
8. Name badges are required and are purchased for cost of approximately \$5.00. Information regarding badges will be given in orientation.
9. Quality leather upper tennis shoes or nurse's shoes (white). Prices can range from \$50 up to \$100. No open backs are allowed and a slight color is acceptable if it is of a tiny emblem on the shoe.
10. Bandage scissors and penlight (Are available at the bookstore or you may purchase elsewhere.)
11. Professional liability insurance (added to your tuition) approximately \$11 in cost. You must go on line and print a receipt for the liability insurance, make a copy for yourself and one to be turned into Denise Sutton for your campus file.
12. Urine drug screening is approximately \$ 30.00
13. You may choose to go the E book option if it is available in your books (most of them are) and that is acceptable as long as you can readily access them to study and prepare for class.
14. Bound syllabus and study guide along with the power points for the entire semester will be for sale during freshmen orientation. The price has not been set as of yet but should not be over 50 or 60 dollars.
15. Tuition is \$140 dollars per credit hour for students in the service area.
